

He currently serves as the President of the Westminster Kennel Club and is Vice-President of the Poodle Club of America. He is a member of the Westchester Kennel Club and the Bull Terrier Club of America. He was honored with ROM judging status by the Bull Terrier Club of America.

United Kennels has had more than twenty different dogs hold the #1 position both in the US and Thailand. United Chows have ranked #1 Chow in the breed more than twenty times in Thailand, and extremely successful in the United States and Asia, having become the #1 Chow in various countries.

Actively pursuing his judging career domestically and abroad, he continues to campaign his outstanding Thai bred dogs in Thailand and the United States.
